






7. To establish Libraries , Book Bureaus etc., for the use of the persons contemplated supra.

- b) Contributions and donations, deposits dedicated for a particular purpose with in the aims and objectives of the trust and other types of contributions, donations and kind of financial assistance rendered by religious, charitable, social and economic organisations.
- c) Interest and other sums received by trust.
- d) Contributions, donations, endowments and such other types of funds given, contributed and donated by individuals, bodies, associations, companies, Organisations, devotees and the public at large.
- e) Properties, movable or immovable, acquired by the trust by transfer, taking over, assignment, purchase, gift, donations, entrustment, lease or any other type of contributions and in favor of the trust.
- f) Income of the organisations, run and managed by the Trust, by way of contributions, donations, fees and other like income.
- g) The trust is at liberty to borrow loans from any persons either individual or corporate bodies or any other body, under any type of contract, subject to the decision of the Board of Trustees for due and efficient implementation of the aims and objectives of the trust.
- h) Family future contributions, towards Trust.


BOARD OF TRUSTEES :-

- a. The Board of Trustees shall ordinarily consist of not less than three and not more than nine members. The Trustees may Co opt to the Board of Trustees, if necessary, by mutual agreement of all the Trustees.
- b. The Board of Trustees shall be Trustees for Life (unless they Resign). The Trustees, whose term of office expires after the period of 5 years, are eligible to be Co-opted as Board of Trustees again by the existing Trustees. The Managing Trustees may if he/she so desires, resign his/her Board of Trusteeship even before the expiry of the terms of his/her Board of Trusteeship.
- c. The Trustees have a power to include the trustees or remove the existing trustees after getting of 2/3rd majority .
- d. Subject to the provisions hereinafter contained, the Trust shall vest in and be administered by a Board of Trustees consisting of One Chairman, One Secretary, and one Treasurer and Three Board of Trustees.

MEETING OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES :-

- a. The Board of Trustees shall meet at least once in two months.
- b. The quorum for a meeting shall be 2/3.
- c. The Secretary shall record the minutes of the meeting and shall cause it to be read and recited in the next meeting and the records would be under his /her acquaintance. The minutes so recorded shall be the conclusive evidence of the decisions taken at the meeting.
- d. Shall consider the annual accounts once in every year within three months of the completion of the financial year and approve the same.
- e. The meeting shall be convened by the Chairman with seven days notice in advance the Board of Trustees shall consider all subjects notified in the notice and such other emergent subjects that may come up in the meeting.

FUNCTIONS OF TRUST & POWERS, FUNCTIONS AND DUTIES OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES:-

- f. The Board of trustees shall meet as open as necessary and their proceedings shall be recorded regularly in the minutes Book to be maintained for the purpose. In any resolution to be passed respecting the administration of the Trust, the opinion of the majority shall prevail. It shall be competent however for the Trustees to decide matters by circulation. In case there being a equality of voters. The Chairman of the meeting has casting vote for the purpose of deciding the issue.
- g. The Board may be resolution extend the activities of the Trust or undertake any activity in furtherance of the main objects of the Trust.
- h. Proper and Regular books of accounts of all Receipts and Expenditure of the Trust shall be maintained by the Trustees either in English or in Kannada.

OFFICE HOURS :- The Office shall be kept open between 10.00 A.M to 5.00 P.M on all working Days.

- I. "YEAR" means the financial year of the Trust. The financial year of the Trust shall be First April to 31st of March of every year.
- II. On 31st March of every year, a general accounts shall be taken up of all Assets and Liabilities of the Trust and an Income and Expenditure Account Shall be prepared and shall be passed by the trustees. Any approved Auditor shall audit the accounts of the Trust or Chartered Accountant appointed by the Board of Trustees for the purpose.



III. To do such other Lawful activities as are incidental in carrying out the administration and management of the Trust.

IV. THE CHAIRMAN

a. He shall hold the office for a period of five years from the date of his assuming the office.

b. The chairman shall represent the trust before all government offices, statutory bodies, local authorities, courts of all kinds, Administrative Tribunals and other officers, to prosecute or defend the interest of the trust as the case may be.

c. Sue and be sued.

d. Shall have the power to open accounts in any bank or financial organisations or other authorities or government bodies who under the law of the land are permitted to run the financial business and banking at such places the Board of Trustees chooses to, in the name of the trust a shall operate the same for and on behalf of the Trust along with the Secretary of the trust with the consent of Board of Trustees.

e. Shall have the power to receive moneys by way of advances loans or such other type of transaction between any individual or Corporate Bodies or Associations or any persons that Board of Trustees may choose to, for the purpose of and on behalf of the Trust, either in India or Abroad.

f. Shall have the power to sign all kinds of papers, and other kinds of correspondence except the execution of documents involving the interest of the trust which is to be done with the Board of Trustees, as stated in clause (b) above.

g. shall be responsible and have power for all acts, deed and things that are necessary in day to day administration and activities of the Trust.




The Board of Trustees generally assists and co-operate with the managing trustees and shall be just and faithful to each other.


IX The trustees may accept any Donation, contribution or Foreign Contribution in cash or in kind from any person, Firm, Company Corporation, Associations, Institutions or Trusts (including the settler or the trustees or any of them) for the furtherance of the objects of the trust or for any one or one of them upon such terms and conditions as they may in their absolute discretion think fit and which are not inconsistent with the objects of the trust. The trustees may take over the management of any other charitable or public institutions.

X) Without affecting the generality of powers and functions of the trustees to manage and administer the trust. The Board of Trustees shall have the following functions.

1. To borrow if need be against the security of assets of the Trusts, by way of Bank Overdraft, Loan or otherwise as may be necessary, for the benefit of the Trust and for more effectively carrying out the objects of the Trust provided however the trustees unanimously agrees on such borrowings and limited to the terms of their decision or agreement and to authorize three or more of the trustees to execute such documents, deeds, paper etc., as may be necessary in connection therewith.
2. To agree for and/or authorize the signing or executing of an agreement, contract, instrument, document or any other paper or writing required be signing or executing on behalf of the Trustees. By any three of the trustees to nominate in this behalf by the Board of Trustees and to make the same effective and binding as if writing were signed by all the trustees.
3. To appoint or make provision for the appointment of a sub-Committee of Trustees and /or others to attend to or supervise or conduct specified jobs or functions or trust, matters in such manner and subject to such regulations as the trustees may prescribe.
4. To authorize any one or more trustees to hold any property or any investment or the Trustee subject however to the terms of these presents if such manner and subject to such terms and conditions, Rules and regulations as the Board of Trustees may from time to time think fit and proper.
5. To send any portion of the corpus or the income of the trust fund for purchasing any land and or constructing any building or buildings for and in the name of the trust for the purpose of carrying out prompting and / or executing any or all of the objects of the Trust.
6. The Trustees shall cause true and accurate accounts to be kept of all moneys received and spent and of all matters in respect thereof in course of management of Trust properties or in relation to the carrying out of the object and purpose of the Trust as well as of all the assets, credits and effects of the trust properties.



7. 9. The Trustees shall be at liberty to sell such portion or portions of the movable or immovable properties in future forming part of the Trust Estate either by public Auction or by private contract at such price or prices and in such terms and condition relating to title or otherwise in all respects as they may in their absolute discretion think fit to and to rescind or vary any contract for the sale there of and to resell the same without being answerable for any loss occasioned thereby and to execute all conveyances or other assurances and to pass valid and effectual receipts and discharges for all moneys received by them.
10. The Trustees shall keep an account or accounts with any Bank or Banks to operate such account or accounts whether in Debit or in Credit and to give all appropriate instructions to the banker or bankers concerning the operation of such account or accounts and to authorize by appropriate resolution two of the Trustees jointly with an agent appointed by the Board of Trustees in this behalf to operate such account or accounts.
11. The Trustees may pay all charges and out goings payable in respect of any immovable property for the time being forming part of the Trust Fund and may carry out repairs requires to be done to the same and keep the same insured against loss or damage by fire and may incur all others costs, charges and expenses incidental to the administration and management of the Trust estate and the Properties for the time being belonging to the trust as they may in their absolute think fit.
12. The Trustees may manage or supervise the management of any land and premises for the time being comprised in the Trust Estate or any part there of with power to effect, pull down, re-build, add to altered repair houses and other buildings and to build drains and make roads and fences and otherwise to improve and develop and to cultivate or cause to be cultivated all or any of the said lands, hereditaments and premises and to insure houses and buildings against loss or damage by fire and / or other risks or to let, lease, take allowances and to arrangements with tenants, agriculturists and generally to ideal with the said land, hereditaments and premises as they may Dena fit in their absolute discretion.



13. The Trustees may appoint Full Time Workers, Secretaries, Managers, Lawyers, Solicitors, Auditors, Architects, Engineers, Surveyors, Gamesters or other Employees for the purpose of management and supervision of the Trust Estate, for collection of Rents and Profits for keeping the accounts and records and for other purpose of the Trust.
14. 16. The Trustees may join, Co-operate and Amalgamate the trust creates by these presents or any portion thereof with any trust or institution having allied and or similar objects upon such terms, as they may in their absolute discretion think fit.
17. The Trustees may from time to time, frame schemes and rules and regulations to carry out the objects of the Trust and for managing the affairs of the Trust and otherwise for giving effect to the objects and purpose of the Trust and to very the same from time to time as the Trustees may in their discretion deem fit and proper.
18. The receipts granted by the Trustees or any one or more of them for any Money, Stock, Funds, Shares, Securities or Investments paid, Delivered or Transferred to then in exercise of the Trustees powers thereof shall effectually release and discharges the person or persons paying, delivering or transferring the same there from and from seeing or from being bound to see the application thereof or being answerable for the loss or misapplication thereof.
19. The Trustees shall be entitles to at there discretion from time to time to Start, discontinue, abolish and re-start and institution, to impose any condition or conditions to any subscription or donation made by them and to earmark and portion of the Trust property or Income for any particular object or object.
20. The Trustees may reimburse themselves and pay and discharge out of the Trust Fund all expenses incurred by them in or about the execution of the trust or any of their duties under these presents including traveling and other genuine expenses, but will not be entitled to any remuneration.
21. All the Trustees unless they voluntarily resign or otherwise decide, shall continue to be the Trustees during the terms of their natural lives.

22. Any Trustees may retire at any time without assigning any reason and without being responsible for any costs occasioned by such retirement.

23. The surviving or continuing trustees may not notwithstanding any vacancy in their board act as trustees PROVIDED HOWEVER that if the numbers of trustees shall not, except for the purpose of filling any vacancy, act so long as the number is below the said minimum.

24. **FIVE** Trustees at a meeting shall form a Quorum for any meeting of the Trustees.

27. In Case of difference of opinion between the trustees, the majority shall prevail and if the trustees are equally divided in any matter, the Chairman shall have a casting vote.

28. A resolution in writing circulated amongst all the trustees and signed by a majority of the trustees shall be as valid and effectual as if it has been passed at a meeting of the trustees duly called and convened.

29. Notice of the meeting of the Trustees and all communication may be sent to the trustees at their addresses registered for the time being in the records of the trust.

30. All meeting of the Trust shall be held at such place and at such time as the Chairman of the trust shall decide from time to time.

31. A Trustee who is unable to be present at a meeting of the Trustees may send his views on the agenda in writing and such expression of opinion shall be taken to be his vote on the matter concerned.

32. The minutes, of the proceeding of every meeting of the trustees shall be entered in a book to be kept for that purpose and signed by the chairman of such meeting or of the following meeting when they are read over and shall when so entered and signed be conclusive evidence of the business and other matters transacted at such meeting.



33. No person being

- i. An un-discharged insolvent; or
- ii. Convicted of an offence involving moral turpitude; or
- iii. Of unsound mind; or
- iv. A Minor;

Shall be eligible to be Trustee;

34. The power to appoint new or additional trustees, but so as not to exceed the maximum number and to fill vacancies in the office of the trustees, shall vest in the continuing trustee or trustees.

35. A person shall seize to be a Trustee in any of the following events:

- a. If he dies;
- b. If he becomes Bankrupt; or
- c. If he becomes insane or otherwise become macramé to act, or
- d. If he resigns his office; or
- e. If he is removed for guilty of misconduct.

36. On a new or additional trustee being appointed and on his signifying his acceptance in writing to the effect of his accepting the appointment. The trust property shall automatically vest in him along with the other trustees for the time being and he will be entitled to carry out all the duties and functions of a trustee without any other deed or writing.

37. The Board of Trustees shall be entitled to sue in the name of the trust and may similarly be sued in the name of the trust.

38. The Board of Trustees may be a unanimous vote of all the trustees for the time being except the trustee proposed to be removed, remove any trustee, permanent or otherwise from office after finding the trustee proposed to be removed guilty of serious misconduct in relation to or concerning the trust estate or trust affairs arriving at a definite conclusion that for the reasons to be recorded in writing to continue of the trustee proposed to be removed as trustees or these presents was desirable. Keeping to the objects of the trusts in view and other related or connected matters provided however that no conclusion of such guilt should be arrived at without giving to the trustee proposed to be removed a full and fair opportunity of explaining facts and/or the charges levied against him for his removal. And the decision of the Board of Trustees in this behalf shall be final and binding and shall not be called in question anywhere.



39. CUSTODY OF DOCUMENTS:

42. RULES and REGULATIONS:


PROVISION:-
